Help these adults in your community improve their skills in reading, writing, and speaking English as a **Tutor** or a **Classroom Aide**.

Tutors

- Provide focused instruction for small learning groups (4-8 students)
- Commit to volunteering three hours a week for 13 weeks
- Must have a Bachelor's Degree

Classroom Aides

- Facilitate small group activities or work one-to-one with a struggling student, under the guidance of classroom teacher
- Commit to volunteering 5-10 hours/month, based on need
- Must have High School degree or equivalent

All Vita volunteers must complete free PA Criminal Background check and Child Abuse Clearances.

Tutors and Classroom Aides are currently needed in Bensalem, Fairless Hills, Levittown, and Warminster.
