Decisions For Living (DFL) tutors work with men and women in the Bucks County Correctional Facility in Doylestown, teaching a logical five-step decision-making process that emphasizes self-awareness, personal responsibility, critical thinking, and goal setting. DFL provides clients with tools to help them reintegrate more effectively into the community upon release.

How do I become a tutor?

Completion of the DFL tutor training is required. You will learn Vita's *Decisions For Living* process and the necessary techniques to teach it to your client. A tour of the Bucks County Correctional Facility is part of the training. Tutors must be at least 21 years of age and complete a criminal background check.
